TSBA PRESIDENT'S LETTER

As we start 2016, I want to say thank you to those members who have worked hard to make the TSBA successful this past year. In particular, I want to thank Eddie Dills for supporting me in his role as Vice President, Larry Nowell for serving as Treasurer and Keith Shannon for being our Secretary; plus those who coordinated our tourneys, published and produced the newsletter, served on the Board and made presentations at our meetings.

In December our Board met and discussed several items, as well as elected officers for 2016. David Powell will be Vice President, Art Muchow is our new Treasurer, Ron Gabler will serve again as Chairman of the Board of Directors and I'll remain the President. Justin Rose will be our Sponsor Coordinator. We still need a Secretary to replace Keith. Also, Doug Steffe would like to pass on the Membership Coordinator function. Please seriously consider helping out the club by serving in one of these roles. Our out going Treasurer, Larry, reported that we have \$10,016 in our checking account. That is slightly more than the end of 2014, so we're in very good shape financially.

If you have ideas for speakers, please contact David Powell, as he has agreed to coordinate this important function for TSBA this year. The Board decided to consider paying for travel expenses when we have out-of-town speakers. That will be decided on a case by case basis. This may allow us to bring in outside speakers who otherwise wouldn't have been able to come to our meetings.

We also decided that, rather than having tourneys, we will have 3 or 4 fishing gettogethers throughout the year. These will not have an entry fee and will include a group picnic-style lunch or dinner, depending on the time we fish. They will be located on various area lakes and at locations where there is a high likelihood of us all catching fish. We'll coordinate non boaters with boaters in an effort to get members to fish with new people where possible. More will follow on this at future meetings.

Since we are in good financial shape, the Board decided to make contributions of \$500 to each of the following: 4-H (to support kid's ability to attend competitions), the Boy Scouts of Jefferson County (for uniforms for needy scouts) and Children's Hospital. We agreed our future is dependent on supporting today's youth and felt this was a small way for us to do that.

Finally, we are changing the monthly meeting date to the 1st Monday of the month starting in January. That means that our next meeting will be on January 4th, still at Puleo's Grill (110 Cedar Ln, just east of the I-75/Merchants Rd. exit. Dinner will continue to be at 6 pm, with the meeting at 7 pm. We really want to increase our meeting attendance. One of the best things about being a member of TSBA is the fellowship we get from getting to know others in the club. While seeing the presentation video on the internet is good for getting information, you'll really miss out if you do this all the time. So try to join us.




